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Rath Chhang is currently a Director of Department of Graduate Programs Accreditation, Accreditation Committee of Cambodia (ACC). He has been involved in developing the minimum standards and guidelines and policies for accreditation of graduate programs. He has been involved in assessment and accreditation of many Foundation Year Programs of higher education institutions in Cambodia. Apart from his full-time job, Chhang also works as a part-time consultant, focusing on teacher training and project monitoring and evaluation.

In 1996, he was employed by the Ministry of Education, Youth, and Sport to be a lecturer for the English Program at RUPP. A part from teaching, Chhang was also interested in human resource management and had a strong commitment to the management of staff development of the English Program. Then, he was appointed as a coordinator of the English Program, which now is called English Language Support Unit (ELSU). In 2002, he was appointed as a manager of Internal Quality Assurance Unit (IQAU) of RUPP. When he was a manager of IQAU, he attended numerous QA conferences and workshops, and he conducted a number of quality assurance activities for the University.

Dr. Rath Chhang has conducted a number of researches, including teacher training in Cambodia, Monitoring and evaluation of the Village Development Partnership Project of Population and Development International Cambodia, and a baseline study on the nature of graduate programs in Cambodian Higher Education. His areas of teaching are Cultural Studies, Foundations of Education, Instructional Leadership and Management, and Language Testing and Assessment.
