



Dr. A. Neil Leveridge is an Educational Technologist, Communication Strategist, and Asst. Professor in the Department of Wood Science in the Faculty of Forestry at UBC. His published research centers on how language learners attain comprehension in multi-modal environments while he has been focusing on research that includes innovations in language assessments, the use of virtual and augmented reality for language learning in Content Language Integrated Learning (CLIL).

Currently, Dr. Leveridge is exploring how teacher-to-student feedback is modulated by the type of communication medium, i.e. how language varies depending on the form of feedback medium, textual, audio, or audio+screencast video.
