A journal article titled "Job Satisfaction of Basic Education Teachers in Southeast Asia: Key Issues and Policy Recommendations' was published on VNU Journal of Science: Education Research in March, 2021. The article is taken from the research project titled "Job Satisfaction of Basic Education Teachers in Southeast Asia", а SEAMEO's inter-center collaborative project, with SEAMEO RETRAC as a lead center. The article presents the key issues affecting the level of job satisfaction among basic education teachers in

Southeast Asia and provides policy recommendations to increase teacher motivation and job satisfaction. The study employs Herzberg's Dual Factor Theory of Motivation: Hygiene factor and motivator factor. Online surveys, group discussions and a forum of educational administrators from all Southeast Asian countries are instruments used to collect data.

# Workshop on "Listening Strategies for IELTS"

At the workshop, Ms. Lori Ann Shea, a Master of Applied Linguistics at Curtin University in Australia with 6 years of teaching experiences and

also the workshop's facilitator, introduced the necessary skills needed for IELTS Listening including prediction, test note-taking, paraphrasing, dealing with distractors to the attendees, as well as listed mistakes which common make students lose points. Real exam questions were also provided so that those who attended the workshop can easily visualize what they will encounter when taking a
